- ➤ It is periodically revised to ensure its constant relevance to the organization, its goals and the evolving external environment.
- ➤ To facilitate a balanced approach between strategic coverage and utility of evaluation, the plan covers four years. Firm proposals are presented for 2022-2023, with indicative proposals for 2024-2025 to be validated in 2023.


