1. *Reaffirms* its decision 1998/1, in which it decided that “Population, gender and development” shall be the special theme for the Commission at its thirty-third session, in the year 2000;
 2. *Decides further* that the special theme for the Commission at its thirty-fourth session shall be “Population, environment and development”;
 3. *Requests* the United Nations Secretariat to submit themes for the thirty-fifth and thirty-sixth sessions of the Commission on Population and Development, in consultation with member States, for a decision by the Commission at its thirty-third session, in the context of a review of the work programme of the Commission.
